

This Indenture witnesseth that Elizabeth David daughter to William David late of Godsall being left to the charge of the Parish hath with the consent of the churchwardens & Overseers of the poor of the said Parish put her selfe Apprentice or Covenant servant unto Richard Smith of Ston Lame husband man & w^{ch} him after the manner of an Apprentise to dwell serve & continue from the feast of All Saints last past before the date of these presents to the full end and terme of sixe yeares from thence next immediately Insuing to be fully comple well & faithfully shall serve his servante shall keep his commande lawfull & honest every where shall doe for in the house of her ma^r or without sh^e shall not commit hurt to her master she shall not doe nor consent to be done her masters business her to be done At Card die or any other unlawfull games she shall not haunt but if it be about matters she shall not wast nor them to any one kind wthout her masters consent Neither money w^{ch} any man w^{ch} in the said terme she shall not contract nor spouse nor from her service neither by day nor night shall absent her selfe but at a trow & faithful shall leave or cause to be taught & instructed after the best maner he can or may so much as belongeth to a woman servant Apparell h^{er} sh^e sh^e lodging & all other necessaries fitting during the said terme and At the end of the said terme she shall be bound to be reformed & kept due by these presents bynd her selfe in all things whiche & Agrements herein contained & on his part to be reformed fulfilled & kept due by these presents bynd himselfe In witness whereof the parties to these presents bynd themselves of our Sovereigne Lord King Charles the second now of England Scotland France & Ireland Defender of the faith 1666
